 - (b) The two Lay Representatives to Synod;

 - (d) The Parish Youth Co-ordinators
 - (e) Not more than (3) three representatives from each Parish Organization., including the Vestry, to be elected by the Respective Organizations;
 - (f) Two other persons in good standing to be appointed by the incumbent.


