Do You Know!

- That GINGER is a spicy herb which enhances the flavour of food. It increases the secretion of saliva, and helps to relieve gas. When taken hot, it also increases the flow of urine.

Ginger also fights inflammation, cleanses the colon, reduces spasms and cramps and stimulates circulation. It is a strong antioxidant and effective antimicrobial agent for sores and wounds.

It protects the liver and stomach and it is useful for bowel disorders, circulatory problems, arthritis, fever, headache, hot flashes, indigestion, morning sickness, motion sickness, muscle pain, nausea and vomiting.

CAUTION: If taken in large quantities it can cause stomach distress. It is not recommended for people who take anticoagulants or have gall stones.
Not recommended for use during pregnancy.

CAUTION: PLEASE consult your doctor before using the above as a tea. The mixture of the tea has to be in proportion. Consequently I suggest you consult the Herbalist.

Old Testament: Malachi 3: 13– 4:2a, 5-6

¹³ "Your words have been stout against me, says the LORD. Yet you say, 'How have we spoken against thee?' ¹⁴ You have said, 'It is vain to serve God. What is the good of our keeping his charge or of walking as in mourning before the LORD of hosts?' ¹⁵ Henceforth we deem the arrogant blessed; evildoers not only prosper but when they put God to the test they escape.'" ¹⁶ Then those who feared the LORD spoke with one another; the LORD heeded and heard them, and a book of remembrance was written before him of those who feared the LORD and thought on his name. ¹⁷ "They shall be mine, says the LORD of hosts, my

special possession on the day when I act, and I will spare them as a man spares his son who serves him. ¹⁸ Then once more you shall distinguish between the righteous and the wicked, between one who serves God and one who does not serve him. ⁴ ¹ "For behold, the day comes, burning like an oven, when all the arrogant and all evildoers will be stubble; the day that comes shall burn them up, says the LORD of hosts, so that it will leave them neither root nor branch. ² But for you who fear my name the sun of righteousness shall rise, with healing in its wings.



The Epistle: 2 Thessalonians 3: 6-13

⁶ Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you keep away from any brother who is living in idleness and not in accord with the tradition that you received from us. ⁷ For you yourselves know how you ought to imitate us; we were not idle when we were with you, ⁸ we did not eat any one's bread without paying, but with toil and labor we worked night and day, that we might not burden any of you. ⁹ It was not because we have not that right, but to give you in our conduct an example to imitate. ¹⁰ For

even when we were with you, we gave you this command: If any one will not work, let him not eat.¹¹ For we hear that some of you are living in idleness, mere busybodies, not doing any work.¹² Now such persons we command and exhort in the Lord Jesus Christ to do their work in quietness and to earn their own living.¹³ Brethren, do not be weary in well-doing.



The Gospel: Luke 21: 5-19

⁵ And as some spoke of the temple, how it was adorned with noble stones and offerings, he said, ⁶ "As for these things which you see, the days will come when there shall not be left here one stone upon another that will not be thrown down." ⁷ And they asked him, "Teacher, when will this be, and what will be the sign when this is about to take place?" ⁸ And he said, "Take heed that you are not led astray; for many will come in my name, saying, 'I am he!' and, 'The time is at hand!' Do not go after them. ⁹ And when you hear of wars and tumults, do not be terrified; for this must first take place, but the end will not be at once." ¹⁰ Then he said to them, "Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom; ¹¹ there will be great earthquakes, and in various places famines and pestilences; and there will be terrors and great signs from heaven. ¹² But before all this they will lay their hands on you and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues and prisons, and

you will be brought before kings and governors for my name's sake. ¹³ This will be a time for you to bear testimony. ¹⁴ Settle it therefore in your minds, not to meditate beforehand how to answer; ¹⁵ for I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which none of your adversaries will be able to withstand or contradict. ¹⁶ You will be delivered up even by parents and brothers and kinsmen and friends, and some of you they will put to death; ¹⁷ you will be hated by all for my name's sake. ¹⁸ But not a hair of your head will perish. ¹⁹ By your endurance you will gain your lives.
